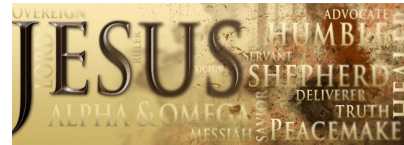

This last week I took some real peace from what Jesus said in Matthew 6:25 *“Do not worry about your life.”* Oswald Chambers wrote with this as his theme scripture last week. He declares, *“Our Lord says be careful only about one thing – our relationship with Him.”* This truth sets our lives in order. Life is more than clothing, shelter and food because many have those things in great supply and much more but they do not have life. Just because physical needs are met does not mean we experience life. Millions are filled with great anxiety today and are spending billions on medications to find peace. The source of real peace is however only found in Christ. He tells us in John 14:27 *“I am leaving you with a gift – peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid.”* What a promise that we can hold on to.

Are you struggling with worry? Let me encourage you to get into the Word this week. Take some time and read Psalm chapters 34 and 37. Memorize Isaiah 26:3 *“You will keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed upon thee because he trusts You.”* II Timothy 1:7 *“God has not given you a spirit of fear but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”* We can claim these promises over our mind and see it transformed into a place where His peace resides.
